

# CalCPA San Diego Chapter Policy and Eligibility Requirements



## San Diego Chapter Scholarship Policy

The purpose of the scholarship program is to promote the future of the CPA profession, provide financial support to meritorious students, encourage student/candidate membership in CalCPA, and enhance CalCPA's visibility at colleges and universities.

### Eligibility Requirements

- Student member or candidate member of CalCPA
- Full or part-time undergraduate or graduate student attending a university/college or community college within the geographical boundaries of the San Diego Chapter
- Enrolled in at least 9 quarter units or 6 semester units with at least one quarter/semester remaining in their academic program/Community College students must intend to transfer to a four year institution
- Have a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or higher

### Apply directly to the institution if you are attending one of the following universities:

- CSUSM
- SDSU
- USD

Please note that the three schools listed above will provide the application and handle the process on behalf of CalCPA.

### Apply directly to CalCPA-San Diego Chapter if you are attending one of the following institutions:

- National University
- UCSD
- Community Colleges

Incomplete applications will not be considered or included in the review process. All applications must be postmarked no later than the deadline date and received at the following address: CalCPA – San Diego Chapter PO Box 16768 San Diego, CA 92176-6768 Attn: Cindy Holcomb.

Based on the pool of qualified applicants, one individual may be selected from each of the following institutions: CSUSM, National University, SDSU, UCSD, USD, and a local community college. Additional recipients may be selected per the discretion of the Scholarship Committee based on merit and/or need. The Scholarship Committee will review and make selections during April. Scholarship amounts may vary between \$500 and \$2500 per individual. Scholarship recipients will be **expected to attend** the Holiday Party in December 2013 unless they have a final examination scheduled during the event.
